About this opportunity: The role involves preparing a variety of meals and other goods for Rosyth Community Hub visitors and The Living Room Cafe customers. You may be chopping and dicing, cooking on the hob as well as in the oven, and plating or portioning up food to be served or chilled. This includes monitoring temperatures and ensuring food is safe to eat, receiving, checking and stocking ingredients and cooking products that are frozen, chilled or dry. Training, including food hygiene, will be provided and may be needed before you can volunteer in earnest in this role. If you can cook at home, with our help, you'll be able to cook in our kitchen.
